

## **Board Director Candidate Interest Form**

Thank you for your interest in serving on Idaho Rural Water Association's (IRWA) Board of Directors. We welcome your enthusiasm to get more involved with the Association. Our mission is to provide technical assistance, training, and a strong representative voice for the benefit of Idaho's drinking water and wastewater utility systems.

To submit your candidacy for a position on the Board of Directors please review and complete this candidate interest form. Forms submitted by November 24<sup>th</sup> will be included on our website <u>and</u> printed in the Winter edition of our quarterly magazine (*The Water Gram*). Forms submitted after November 24<sup>th</sup> but prior to February 28<sup>th</sup> will be posted on our website only.

**Board Director Eligibility:** To be eligible as an IRWA Board Member, the person must either be an employee, elected official or voting member of the member system at the time of election. No former Association employee whose employment has been terminated for cause shall be eligible for election to the Board of Directors.

Board Director Term: Two (2) years

**Board Directors Compensation:** No director is entitled to compensation except for reimbursement of reasonable expenses for Association business.

## The duties of the Board of Directors are as follows:

- a. To conduct and supervise the affairs of the Association, including the designation of committees.
- b. To take charge of and be responsible for the property of the Association's finances and the proceedings of the Association.
- c. To initiate, supervise and approve plans and programs designed to achieve the objectives and purposes of the Association.
- d. To implement policies, programs or plans adopted at the annual meeting of the members.
- e. To determine policies of the Association consistent with the objectives and purposes of the Association as set out in the Articles of Incorporation.
- f. To provide for and attend annual and special meetings of the Association.
- g. To arrange for the annual audit of the Association by a certified public accountant.
- h. To provide for the dissemination of information to the members and to the public generally as may be needed to provide suitable publicity for the work and status of the Association.
