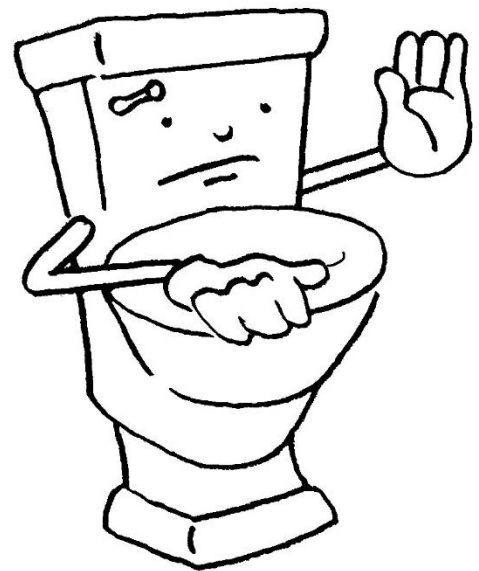


Don't treat your drains like a trash can!

When inappropriate items are flushed down the toilet or poured down the drain it damages your community wastewater treatment facility. These facilities are not designed to remove items other than human waste. It costs your utility money fix these issues, and as a result **your utility bill could go up to offset the cost of repairs!**

Do not flush or pour the following items:

- Baby wipes, *even if they say flushable!*
- Diapers
- Feminine products, including applicator
- Floss, plastics, or condoms
- Cotton swabs or cotton balls
- Kitty litter or pet waste
- Grease, oil, or foods
- Pharmaceuticals
- Cleaning products
- Towels, rags, sponges, or clothing
